



# Topic... Otago Art Society (OAS)

**Past...** The OAS started in 1876, next year it will be having it's 150th Birthday 



The Railway Station Dunedin has today, was opened in 1906 which means it will be 120 years old in 2026. The dark rock came from Kokonga and the white stone from Oamaru. The original main floor had 725,760 porcelain squares made by Royal Doulton in England.



If you look at the top of the clock tower there are lions and unicorns holding shields.



## Present...





• They were philanthropists, contributing much to the life of the community.






• Olveston and its original contents were gifted to Dunedin by the daughter, Dorothy, in 1966.
